- b. Chief presented a draft budget proposal for 2022 for review. Still waiting for Grays Harbor to finalize tax revenue.
- c. COLA Discussion Chief brought to the attention of the board the inequality of the COLA's throughout the staff. Chief proposed an equal COLA throughout the staff. Commissioner Patton views COLA as performance-based raise, Commissioner Hauge explained the difference COLA and performance-based raise. He also requested this issue to be table for one month. Commissioner Patton agreed, discussion tabled.
